

## **2010 NSCAD University/Nova Scotia Health Research Foundation (NSHRF) Student Award Competition Application & Agreement**

This Award Competition will celebrate the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the **Nova Scotia Health Research Foundation (NSHRF)**. Developing a fuller understanding of the integration of art and science is a key component of the competitive process. The competition will be designed **to raise awareness of elements that contribute to excellence in scientific and health research.**

Recognizing **the synergies of art and health for mind and body**, the NSHRF will provide awards (for a total of three) of \$5000, \$3000 and \$2000 for NSCAD full-time students. The successful artworks will remain the property of the NSHRF and the artwork will be credited to the artist in all reproductions.

*The criterion for the award is as follows:*

- *Any Full-Time graduate or undergraduate student working in any of the following disciplines, Sculpture, Design, Drawing, Painting, Jewellery, Metalsmithing, Textiles, Photography, Printmaking, and Ceramics is eligible to apply for the award.*
- *Must be a new work*
- *The work will be displayed in an office – indoors*
- *Content should be suitable for a public office.*

with a closing date of 4:00 pm on March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

The NSHRF Award jury will select and award:

One 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: \$5,000

One 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$3,000

One 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$2,000.

The awards may be announced in graduation publicity for May 15<sup>th</sup> 2010. The final artwork is to be completed by September 30, 2010. Prize money will be disbursed after artwork has been produced, accepted and delivered to NSHRF. More information about the NSHRF can be found on the web at

**Eligibility:**

***Any Full-Time graduate or undergraduate student working in any of the following disciplines, Sculpture, Design, Drawing, Painting, Jewellery, Metalsmithing, Textiles, Photography, Printmaking, and Ceramics are eligible to apply to the competition.*** Please forward this completed **Form**, the completed **Proposal Template** a **Resume**, the names of **Two Faculty References** and forward with **NO More Than Four (4) digital images** and/or scanned sketches. The file(s) must meet the following standard Canada Council specifications for digital submissions:

- Only JPEG image-format saved at high-quality/low-compression setting are acceptable. Low-quality/high-compression JPEGs will not be accepted.
- High resolution images must be 300 dpi, and approximately 14" x 10.5" (4200 x 3150 pixels). Low resolution images must be 72 dpi and have a maximum size of 1024 x 768 pixels.
- All images should be in RGB color mode (CMYK will not be accepted).
- All file names must be composed of a number followed by a title. Single digit numbers must start with zero "0" (ex.: "01title.jpg"... "09title.jpg", "10title.jpg"). Do not use punctuation or symbols in the titles.
- Compressed archive files (.zip, .sit) will not be accepted.

A Number Key List of Images must be typed on an 8 1/2" x 11" sheet. The Number Key List of Images must also appear in electronic Microsoft Word format on the CD-ROM . This list should include image number, name of image for each image provided.
